Roles

The following roles will help ensure everyone on your team understands their responsibilities. This provides the framework for good team work and a fun art start year! The **Art Start Lead** is the liaison to the teacher for the art start team. The lead also typically defines the lesson plan (using the “Lesson Planner” template) and teaches the class the art lesson. Utilizing the “Lesson Planner” document will help plan the lesson and define the materials needed to be reserved.

Art Start Lead:

The **Documentation and Display Lead** shows off your success as a team and a class by organizing the art start hallway bulletin board for your class, and uploading lesson plans and pictures to the [mcauliffeart website](http://mcauliffeartwebsite.com). The DD Lead utilizes the “Lesson Planner” document created by the Art Start Lead to define the lesson plan on the website and takes pictures during the lesson to include in the website entry or for use in bulletin board display (these come in handy for 3 dimensional works that don’t hang well like clay and glass). Please only post pictures of student’s hands on the website for privacy reasons (no faces). Confirm with your teacher which is the bulletin board for your class.

Documentation and Display Lead:

Assistants are vital to making your lesson successful. Assistants ensure kids are on task and following instructions, supplies are available at the proper time, and clean up occurs efficiently. Assistants also help the Art Start Lead reserve supplies, and return supplies to their proper place.
